

## Farm

We were able to combine the three remaining plot areas of soybeans this week. The beans were actually in good condition considering the delay in harvesting. Lime was also spread on the rest of the areas scheduled for this year. These were plot areas had a less than 5.8 soil test reading. A total of 126 tons of lime have been applied at a rate of 1 ton per acre. The 2440 and the pull behind spreader were used to spread the areas where the soil conditions were too wet for the spreader truck to work.

## Research

Herbicide and fertilize applications were made to all wheat areas on Monday and Tuesday of this week. We were able to use both the 6000 highboy and the 685 tractor for the herbicide treatments. The fertilize was delivered and spread by Southern States.

## Comments

The funding of a irrigation well has been approved and we are in the process of obtaining bids. The plan is for this well to have the pumping capacity needed to maintain an adequate water supply in the main irrigation holding ponds during times like this past summer.

Winter-time repair and clean-up work continued inside facilities this week when time allowed. Jason was able to repair several light fixtures and wall receptacles that were defective and in need of attention.
