Irrigation was only required on only one plot area this week. We watered area b29a for Dr. Knapp where they were able to transplant watermelons on Tuesday. Mowing continues to be an ongoing job with the 5200 now being used to pull the 15' batwing mower most of the time. The larger tractors are busy most of the time with planting duties.

Research

This week was a productive week for the soybean program here at the PSF. Dale and his crew were able to plant plots in a total of 29 different areas this week. The PSF then received .62" of gentle rain that took care of watering in all of these plot areas which already had fairly good moisture.

Jason and Dean were able to take care of planting cotton in area c32 this week and sweet corn in area b118 for use with Dr. All's program. The only other planting this week was the watermelons that Prothro and crew planted in area b29a. Greg was also able to harvest more of their plot areas that are part of Dr. Hancock's program here at the PSF.
