Rains fell most of the week Oct 12-16, and the UGA soil judging team spent three days in the mud describing the soils of the Cumberland Plateau in Crossville, TN in preparation for the Southeast Regional Soil Judging competition. Ten other teams competed in the contest hosted by the University of Tennessee/Knoxville. UGA placed fifth overall in the team rankings, with Louise Jacques and Audrey Morgan placing in the top 10 individual scores out of more than 80 contestants.
