Eligibility: Undergraduate student majoring in the field of crop/plant sciences  
Criteria: Academic merit and financial need.  
Award: \$1,000 - divided between Fall and Spring Semester  
To Apply: Submit Departmental Application

#### ***Crop and Soil Sciences International***

Eligibility: Any student majoring in Crop and Soil Sciences participating in a University related Study Abroad Program  
Criteria: Academic merit and financial need  
Award: Number of awards and amount of each determined annually  
To Apply: Submit letter of financial need and program of study along with supporting documentation.

Eligibility: Any student majoring in an area related to soil science  
Criteria: None  
Award: \$1,000 - Divided between Fall and Spring Semesters  
To Apply: Submit departmental application and one page biographical sketch

Criteria: Academic merit - minimum 3.0 GPA
